

# Your Timeline - ceremony with us!

Every wedding is unique, and the flow of your day will depend on your chosen ceremony time and location. Here's an example of how your special day could look with a 1pm ceremony at Tyn Dwr Hall.

# 8.00am/10.00am - Dressing Room Check-In

If there's no wedding the day before, you can access the Dressing Room from 8am; otherwise, it's available from 10am. Settle in with your wedding party, enjoying drinks and pastries as you transform into your vision of perfection.

### 11.30am - Partner Arrival

Your partner arrives, ensuring the Dressing Room remains your private sanctuary. This allows each of you to focus on your final preparations, enjoy some photography, and relax before guests start arriving.

### 12.00pm - Guest Arrival

Guests begin to arrive, greeted with drinks at the bar and a chance to explore the stunning Main Hall. If there's no wedding the day before, room check-in is from 12pm; otherwise, check-in will open at 2pm.

# 12.30pm - Registrar Meeting

The registrars will meet with you both individually to confirm details and ensure everything is ready for the ceremony.

# 12.45pm - Bar Closes

We'll kindly close the bar and look after guests' drinks as they make their way to the ceremony space, eagerly awaiting your arrival.

# 12.50pm - Bridal/Groom Party Reveal

Bridesmaids or groomsmen gather at the bottom of the staircase for a breathtaking dress or suit reveal moment—always a highlight of the day!

# 1.00pm - The Ceremony

Filled with love, laughter, and promises, your ceremony marks the official start of your married life together.

1.30pm - Confetti and Drinks Reception 8.00pm - First Dance Share your first dance as a married couple—a Celebrate your first moments as newlyweds with a joyful confetti shot, truly magical moment followed by drinks, canapes and mingling with your guests. before the party kicks off!

# 8.00am/10.00am - Dressing Room Check-In

# 11:50pm - Bridal/Groom Party Reveal Bridesmaids or groomsmen gather at the bottom of the staircase for a breathtaking dress or suit reveal moment—always a highlight of the day!

# 12.00pm - Getting you to the Church on time

Using your booked transport, get comfortable in a limo with all your party, or in separate cars in style and start to make your way to your place of worship. This time is often an emotional one for last minute good lucks and proud chats. 12.30pm - The Ceremony Filled with love, laughter, faith and promises, your ceremony marks the official start of your married life together.

### 1.00-1.30pm - Confetti and pictures
